CONSTITUTION FOR THE MARSHFIELD HIGH SCHOOL ATHLETIC HALL OF FAME

ARTICLE I PREAMBLE

Marshfield High School Hall of Fame is a memorial to outstanding individuals who, through their exceptional achievements, have brought honor to themselves, their school and the community.

ARTICLE II PURPOSE OF HALL OF FAME

The purpose of the Marshfield High School Hall of Fame is to formally recognize outstanding contributions to the heritage and tradition of the Pirate athletic program.

It is the intent of this Hall of Fame to honor and preserve the memory of athletes, teams, coaches and other whose achievements have brought recognition and honor to Marshfield High School and its athletic program.

A criterion for selection not only includes achievement while at Marshfield High School, but possibly other accomplishments in post high school athletics.

Each inductee will receive a plaque highlighting the accomplishments of the inductee. A duplicate plaque will be displayed at Marshfield High School.

ARTICLE III CRITERIA FOR ELGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS FOR THE HALL-OF-FAME NOMINEES

Candidates are eligible through at least <u>one</u> of the four classifications:

1. <u>ATHLETIC:</u>

State Champion or All State in events or brought fame to Marshfield in high school or post high school athletics.

2. <u>BUCK WILLIAMS PIRATE BOOSTER:</u>

Private citizens who have been great "Pirate" boosters and have made outstanding contributions to the athletic programs at Marshfield High School.

3. <u>SCHOOL DISTRICT EMPLOYEE;</u>

Individuals who have made outstanding contributions to the Marshfield High School programs-Such as: coaches, administrators, teachers, etc.

4. <u>ACADEMICS:</u>

Outstanding Marshfield Scholar/Athlete who have brought honor and fame to Marshfield by their outstanding post high school civic achievements and/or professional careers.

ARTICLE V CANDIDATES FOR MEMBERSHIP

Candidates for membership in the Hall of Fame shall be former Marshfield High School students and personnel who meet the requirements set forth in this constitution. In order to be inducted, candidate must receive a 2/3-majority vote + 1 from the Marshfield High BM/SC.
